

Trimble 0-60 Challenge 2026

Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction.

The Trimble 0-60 Challenge is a global initiative designed to identify and support the most innovative startups within the Architecture, Engineering, Construction, and Geospatial industries (“Industry”). The program aims to foster the development of integrated hardware and software solutions that expand the Trimble ecosystem, delivering new value to customers by solving complex industry challenges.

In this call to action, Trimble Inc. (“Trimble”) is seeking entrepreneurs, early-stage startups (small to medium), and developers to turn their innovative ideas into industry solutions. Participants are invited to address common pain points for Industry professionals through one of the following three challenge categories:

- Category I: Connected Data
- Category II: Connected Design
- Category III: Connected Field or Jobsite

As part of the Challenge, participants must leverage the Trimble platform by integrating with or utilizing one or more of the following Trimble solutions:

- Software Solutions: Trimble Connect, ProjectSight, SketchUp, Tekla, Field Software, and Office Software.

Hardware Solutions: GNSS receivers, total stations, and laser scanners.

This document contains the terms and conditions (“Terms”) applicable to participation in the Trimble 0-60 Challenge (the “Challenge”).

2. Challenge Objectives and Scope.

2.1. Objective: The objective of the Challenge is to accelerate the development of transformative technology solutions that address critical industry pain points within the Architecture, Engineering, Construction, and Geospatial sectors. Participants are tasked with leveraging the Trimble ecosystem—integrating with or utilizing Trimble Connect, ProjectSight, SketchUp, Tekla, Field Software, or Office Software, and/or incorporating Trimble hardware such as GNSS receivers, total stations, and laser scanners.

2.2. Scope:

The Challenge is an invitation to startup companies, small businesses and commercial developers and entrepreneurs (“Participants”) to submit a technology solution (“Solution”) addressing the Challenge objective in one of the Submission Categories set forth below (each, a “Submission”).

The detailed description of the Challenge is available at <https://www.trimble.com/en/our-company/events/dimensions/experiences/0-60-challenge> (“Challenge Website”) and is subject to change by Trimble at any time up to Selection Day. Submissions submitted prior to the modification of the Challenge shall continue to be valid as long as they comply with all published requirements at the time of submission.

3. Procedures, Standards and Requirements for Participation.

3.1. Submission Requirements. All Participants must tender a Submission through the Challenge Website, which will detail the necessary materials to be included in the Submission. Only one Submission per Participant will be accepted. In the event Participant submits several Submissions, only the last Submission will be evaluated.

3.2. Submission Categories. Submissions must address one of the following three categories, focusing on Industry challenges:

- Category I: Connected Data. Solutions that facilitate the seamless flow, management, and interoperability of data across the project lifecycle.
- Category II: Connected Design. Solutions that enhance modeling, simulation, and design

workflows to improve accuracy and efficiency.

- Category III: Connected Field or Jobsite. Solutions that optimize real-world execution through hardware-to-software synergy and the use of Trimble precision technology.

3.3. Participation Requirements

The following Participants may participate in the Challenge:

- **Entrepreneurs**
- **Start-ups (Early-Stage)**
- **Developers**

Additional details regarding the foregoing Submission Categories and Participation Requirements can be found on the Challenge Website.

In all instances, Participants must meet the following Participation Requirements: (i) the individual submitting the Submission must be a natural person, of legal age and with legal capacity to bind him/herself, and who will act on, and is authorized to act on, behalf of the Participant; and (ii) the data provided by the Participant in the Submission must be truthful. Participants whose data is incorrect or incomplete will not be able to participate in the Challenge. Trimble reserves the right to refuse to accept or to remove from the Challenge, without prior notice, all Participants who, in Trimble's opinion, act fraudulently, abusively, or contrary to the spirit of the Challenge, applicable law, third-party rights, and/or good faith. Trimble may also remove any Participant or related person whose actions may be detrimental to Trimble's reputation or good name.

None of the foregoing shall entitle any Participant or potential Participant to any right or claim whatsoever against Trimble for damages, expenses, or liabilities.

3.4. Challenge Cancellation

Trimble reserves the right to cancel the Challenge at any time for any reason. This decision will be communicated to Participants via the Challenge Website. Nothing herein shall obligate Trimble to, and Trimble provides the Participants with no guarantee that, Trimble will, accept and/or evaluate any Submission.

4. **Program Phases.**

4.1 Submission Period.

Trimble will accept Submissions from Participants beginning on February 27, 2026 until May 22, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. MST ("Submission Period"). Trimble may, in its sole discretion, extend the period for receipt of Submissions. Such modification will be published via the Challenge Website.

4.2 Submission Evaluation.

The Submission evaluation process, which will last for one week after the end of the Submission Period, will be divided into the following phases:

1. **Initial Submission Screening:** The Trimble team ("Trimble Evaluation Team") will verify each Submission's compliance with these, as well as the suitability of the proposed Solution to the applicable Challenge. Should the Submission fail to comply with the Participation Requirements and/or not respond to the Challenge, it will not be considered
2. **Evaluation of the Submission:** The Submission will be evaluated in detail by the Trimble Evaluation Team who will select the finalists for each Challenge. Where necessary, Trimble will request additional information or meetings to resolve any technical questions that may arise.

The evaluation will be carried out in accordance with the criteria defined in the Criteria for Evaluating

the Proposals section.

Trimble will notify the Participants via email if they are invited to participate in the next phase of the Challenge (“Selected Participants”). Likewise, non-selection will be communicated via email to the contact email address provided in the Submission.

4.3 Selection Day

The Selected Participants will be notified on May 29, 2026 via email at the conclusion of the Submission evaluation process. Following notification, Selected Participants will receive additional details about the 3-month program and instructions to attend the Kick-off Meeting on June 17--18, 2026, which will be held in-person at Trimble’s offices in Westminster, Colorado or virtually.

It is mandatory that at least one representative from each Selected Participant be present during the Kick-off Meeting. It is important that the representative be an active member of the Selected Participant’s working team. Failure to attend the Kick-off Meeting constitutes sufficient reason for Participants’ removal from the Challenge. Each Selected Participant will be responsible for its own means of transportation and accommodation when attending the Kick-off Meeting.

4.4 : Participation Agreement; Next Phase Requirements

The Participation Agreement is the contractual framework that governs the relationship between the Selected Participant and Trimble throughout the remainder of the Challenge and will only be provided to Selected Participants and Each Selected Participant must sign the Participation Agreement within fifteen (15) days after receiving notice that they are a Selected Participant and prior to participation in the Kick-Off Meeting.

The Selected Participants will work together with the assigned Trimble Evaluation Team to define and/or finalize the scope of the Selected Participant’s Solution.

This phase of the Challenge will be held virtually and will have a maximum duration of three (3) months, to align with a Demo Day event to be held at Trimble’s annual Dimensions conference (“Dimensions”), which will be held in Las Vegas, Nevada scheduled on November 9-11, 2026.

4.5 Progress Reviews and Checkpoints

A series of progress reviews and checkpoints will be set throughout the next phase of the Challenge to evaluate the results achieved on a bi-weekly basis. During this process, Selected Participants will give a presentation to the Trimble Evaluation Team of their Solution’s evolution, key milestones achieved, and next steps. Based on the information provided by the Selected Participants, the Trimble Evaluation Team may provide the Selected Participants with feedback.

4.6 Demo Day

The Selected Participants will be invited to participate and present their Solution during Demo Day at Dimensions. Prior to Demo Day, Participants will meet virtually with the Trimble Evaluation Team to prepare presentations and materials. Participants will then be required, one- to two days prior to Demo Day, to meet in-person in Las Vegas for a dry run of their presentations.

4.7 Challenge Wrap-up and Post-Challenge Support

Upon completion of the Challenge, Trimble will meet with Selected Participants to collect lessons learned, solicit feedback for improving the Challenge, and discuss how to best support Selected Participants moving forward.

The Challenge phases may be updated in the future and any such changes will be shared via the Challenge Website.

No information will be provided on the individual evaluation of each Submission. Trimble’s decision on any aspect of the selection process will be final and not subject to appeal.

5. Criteria for Evaluating the Submissions.

Submissions will be evaluated based on how well the Solution addresses the following criteria:

- **The Solution must:**
 - solve an Industry customer pain point focused on the three Submission Categories (Connected Data, Connected Design, or Connected Field);
 - enhance a Trimble workflow in Industry operations;
 - integrate with the Trimble ecosystem, utilizing software such as Project Sight, SketchUp, Trimble Connect, or Tekla, and/or incorporating hardware including GNSS receivers, total stations, or laser scanners; and
 - show commercial growth potential and the ability to deliver scalable value to global customers.

6. Benefits of Participating.

The Selected Participants will have access to the following benefits:

- Access to a Trimble Evaluation Team throughout the 12-week period following Selection Day to assist with the continued development of the Submission;
- The opportunity to present the Solution at Dimensions;
- Visibility and awareness within Trimble's industry; and
- Trimble may, but is not obligated to, provide financial sponsorship for Selected Participants. The amount of such sponsorship, if any, and the applicable terms, conditions, and related obligations shall be set forth in the Participation Agreement between Trimble and the Selected Participant.

7. Independent Development; Information and Submissions Not Confidential.

PARTICIPANT ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT TRIMBLE DEVELOPS A VARIETY OF PRODUCTS AND SERVICES AND WORKS WITH MANY OTHER DEVELOPERS AND PARTNERS, AND EITHER TRIMBLE OR THESE THIRD PARTIES COULD, IN THE FUTURE, DEVELOP (OR ALREADY HAVE DEVELOPED) PRODUCTS, SERVICES, CONCEPTS, OR FEATURES SIMILAR TO PARTICIPANT'S SUBMISSION, AND NOTHING HEREIN LIMITS TRIMBLE'S RIGHT TO DO SO. UNLESS AND UNTIL THE PARTIES EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CONFIDENTIALITY OBLIGATIONS, ALL INFORMATION SUBMITTED BY A PARTICIPANT TO TRIMBLE RELATED TO OR ARISING FROM THE CHALLENGE SHALL BE MADE ON A NON-CONFIDENTIAL BASIS.

8. Trimble Image Rights.

Participants authorize Trimble to disclose and publish on the internet, social networks, and in any other type of media, a summary of the selected Submissions, as well as the irrevocable and perpetual right to use the logo(s), image(s) and name of the Participants responsible for such Submissions to promote, market, and implement the Challenge, and for uses related to Trimble's Challenge-related activities.

9. Personal Information; Data Protection.

If the processing of personal information by Trimble is subject to the General Data Protection Regulation ((EU) 2016/679) or the Data Protection Act 2018 of the United Kingdom, then, in addition, at the written request of Participant, the parties will execute an applicable data processing addendum, available at <https://www.trimble.com/privacy/DPA-TI-EuroSubs> (or any successor URL). Transfers of personal information from Trimble entities located in Europe, acting as data exporter, to Trimble entities in the USA, acting as data importer, are governed, for the benefit of Participant, by the Standard Contractual Clauses available at the same URL or upon written request from Participant to Trimble. If the processing of personal information by Trimble is subject to US data protection laws, rules or regulations, then the US Data Processing Addendum for Customer Personal Information

(available at https://dl.trimble.com/www/us_dpa_customer.pdf (or any successor URL) is herein incorporated by reference.

10. Intellectual Property Rights.

By participating in the Challenge, the Participant: (i) grants Trimble all necessary rights and license, in perpetuity, to use the Participant's name (both the Participant entity and the individual Participant contributor(s)), to publicize the Challenge and the Selected Participants' Submissions without compensation; and (ii) guarantees that the Submissions are the original works of the Participants. By tendering a Submission, the Participant does not assign or transfer any intellectual property rights to Trimble.

11. Indemnification.

UPON REQUEST BY TRIMBLE, PARTICIPANT WILL DEFEND, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS TRIMBLE AND ITS AFFILIATES, AGENTS, AND THIRD PARTIES, AND ITS AND THEIR EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS, OFFICERS, AND DIRECTORS FROM ALL DAMAGES, LIABILITIES, CLAIMS, AND EXPENSES, INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES, THAT ARISE FROM (A) PARTICIPANT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE CHALLENGE, (B) PARTICIPANT'S BREACH OF APPLICABLE LAWS, OR (B) INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY INFRINGEMENT ARISING FROM OR RELATED TO PARTICIPANT'S SUBMISSION. TRIMBLE RESERVES THE RIGHT, AT ITS OWN EXPENSE, TO ASSUME THE EXCLUSIVE DEFENSE AND CONTROL OF ANY MATTER OTHERWISE SUBJECT TO INDEMNIFICATION BY PARTICIPANT, IN WHICH EVENT PARTICIPANT AGREES TO COOPERATE WITH TRIMBLE IN ASSERTING ANY AVAILABLE DEFENSES. PARTICIPANT MAY NOT SETTLE ANY CLAIM WITHOUT THE PRIOR WRITTEN CONSENT OF TRIMBLE IN EACH CASE.

12. Limitation of Liability.

TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, (i) TRIMBLE SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR LOSS OF PROFIT OR REVENUE, DATA THAT IS LOST OR CORRUPTED, FAILURE OF SECURITY MECHANISMS, INTERRUPTION OF BUSINESS, LOSS OF GOODWILL, OR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, RELIANCE, INDIRECT, PUNITIVE, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND; AND (ii) TRIMBLE'S ENTIRE LIABILITY FOR ANY AND ALL DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE AGREEMENT WILL NOT EXCEED IN AGGREGATE \$100.

13. Acceptance of Guidelines

By registering for the Challenge, Participant fully and unconditionally accepts these Terms, as well as the agreements and decisions adopted by Trimble within the framework of the Challenge. Trimble reserves the right to modify the Terms of this Challenge at any time, including its possible cancellation, and undertakes to give sufficient advance notice of the new rules or, where appropriate, the definitive cancellation, through the channels provided for this purpose, without this giving rise to any right of claim on the part of the Participants for any reason whatsoever.

14. Choice of Law; Venue. These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of Delaware. Trimble and the Participants agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the federal or state courts located in Wilmington, Delaware, USA.
